



Coming Back Details

- Save parking spots near front doors of sanctuary for those who need short trips to the front door
- Going under the awning into the children's side of the building is reserved for those who are wearing masks – anyone (mask or no mask) can enter the main front doors
 - These will be the only two doors available in the church. If you have a key to the building, please honor these instructions and go through the two open doors.
- When you come in, there will be a laser (no touch) temperature checking station. Anyone with a fever above 100.4 will be asked to leave and watch online. Please be patient. We feel this is one of the best ways we can protect our most vulnerable population as it seems symptomatic people pass the virus most frequently.
 - Side Note: There is no timetable for the temperature taking. We try to make the best decision we can at any given time. We are not scientists. This committee is helping me shepherd the flock God has entrusted to me (see 1 Peter 5:1-5).¹
- There will be no childcare or children's ministry in this Phase 1 return. Most churches are looking at an August timeframe and we will probably follow suit in that regard.
- We are installing hospital grade air filters to help clean the air.
- We will have hand sanitizer available. Fair warning: it does not smell good.
- Online streaming and CD/ DVD delivery will continue
- We are using a Covid-approved sanitizing chemical to spray down all touch points (including pews) between meetings

¹ So I exhort the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed: ² shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; ³ not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock. ⁴ And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory. ⁵ Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
